4. Please note that pursuant to clause (46) (b) of the Fiji Sugar Tradesmen constitution and rules any person contesting for the positions of President and Secretary of a branch must have served three years as a committee member in the branch.
5. Any candidate for the positions of President or Secretary of a branch must attached with their nomination a letter from the Fiji Sugar Tradesmen Union confirming that he/ she has served as a committee member for three (3) years.
6. Candidates who wish to withdraw their nomination must do so by **4pm on Tuesday 10 March, 2015**. Withdrawals must be in writing, signed by the candidate and delivered or sent to the Returning Officer, Ms Anaseini Senimoli at the Fijian Elections Office, 183 Vitogo Parade, Lautoka.
7. To be able to vote, a valid photo ID (such as the EVR card) must be produced to the election officials.
