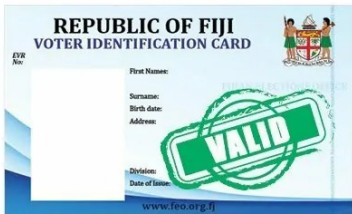

Who can register to Vote?

Any person who:

1. Has reached the age of 18 years;
2. Is a citizen of Fiji;
3. Is not serving a sentence of imprisonment of 12 months or longer imposed by a court of law in Fiji or by a court of another country; or
4. Under a law in force in Fiji, is not declared to have a mental disorder.

What document is required for Voter Registration?

1. Original or certified true copy of Birth Certificate; and
2. A valid photo ID i.e. Fijian Passport, Driver's License, FNPF/Joint Card etc.

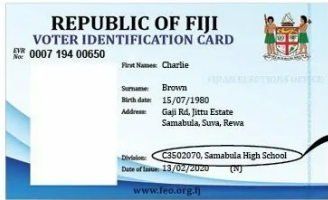

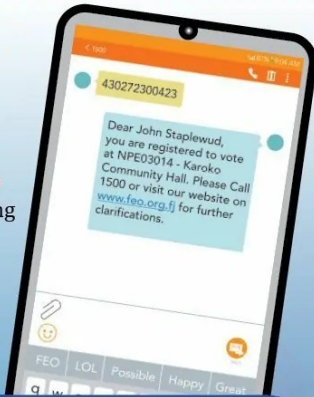
Check your Polling Venue



Polling Venue details.

OR

Text your voter number to **1500** to get your Polling Venue details.



As a registered voter, it is your responsibility to:

- Continuously update your voter details;
- Keep your VoterCard safe and secure;
- Report deceased voters;
- Check for latest election information; and
- Vote at any General Election.

Steps of the Voting Process at the Polling Station

STEP 1: Venue Queue Control
You will be directed to the correct Polling Station by the Venue Queue Controller.

STEP 2: Inside Queue Control
Please ensure that you are wearing your mask properly. Your fingers will be checked for ink marking and then you will be asked to sanitize your hands. The Inside Queue Controller will remind you to have your VoterCard or valid photo ID ready before issuing you with a Voter Instruction Booklet.

STEP 3: Identification
You will need to show your VoterCard or valid photo ID to the ID Officer/ Ballot Paper Issuer who will confirm your name on the Voter List.

STEP 4: Signature
Please sign the Voter List in the 'Signature' column using the Voter List Stencil.

STEP 5: Issuing the Ballot Paper
You will then be issued with **1** Ballot Paper and instructed on how to mark the Ballot Paper.

STEP 6: Marking the Ballot Paper
Proceed to the Cardboard Voting Booth, look through the Voter Instruction Booklet to identify the number of the candidate you would like to vote for and either **Circle** or **Tick** or **Cross** the number on the Ballot Paper. Once you are done, fold the Ballot Paper into 2.

STEP 7: Inking
The Inking Officer will then mark your index finger or little finger on the left hand.

STEP 8: Placing Ballot Paper in Ballot Box
You will now put the folded Ballot Paper in the Ballot Box.

STEP 9: Leaving Polling Station and Polling Venue
You will receive an 'I VOTED' sticker before leaving the Polling Station and Polling Venue.
