Warning - Section 136 (a) of the Electoral Act 2014 and Section 127(a) of the Electoral (Local Government Election) Regulations 2025:
Any person who knowingly and willfully makes a false statement or declaration in connection with an application for registration as a voter in the General Election or Local Government Election commits an offence. A person convicted of an offence under section 136(a) of the Electoral Act 2014 is liable to a fine not exceeding \$50,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years, or to both. A person convicted of an offence under the Electoral (Local Government Election) Regulations 2025 (a Category A offence) is liable, under regulation 125, to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 in the case of any other person and will be disqualified from registering on the National Register of Voters for a period of 4 years.
