Card?

WHO IS ELIGIBLE for a **VOTER** identification **CARD**?

A person who:

1. Has reached the age of 18 years;
2. Is a citizen of Fiji;
3. Is not serving a sentence of imprisonment of 12 months or longer imposed by a court of law in Fiji; and
4. Is not declared to be of unsound mind.

Has the right to be registered as a voter.

What are the **REQUIREMENTS** when applying for a **NEW VOTER** identification **CARD** or **CORRECTING** information on **VOTER CARD**?

Present any of the following Photo IDs with your Birth Certificate (Original or Certified True Copy)

- Fiji Passport; or
- Fiji National Provident Fund (FNPF) Card; or
- Driver's License; or
- Social Welfare ID; or
- T.I.N (Joint Fiji Island Revenue Customs Authority (FIRCA) /FNPF Card; or
- Student ID from any Tertiary Institution registered with the Fiji Higher Education Commission; or
- Marriage Certificate (if the voter chooses to use the their spouse's name).

What are the **REQUIREMENTS** for **FIJI CITIZENS** who are born overseas?

Present any of the following with your Birth Certificate (Original or Certified True Copy)

- Fiji Passport; or
- Any other Current Photo ID with Certificate of Citizenship; or
- Certificate of Naturalization; or
- Certificate of Registration as a Citizen of Fiji; or
- Confirmation letter from the Fiji Department of Immigration.



What are the **REQUIREMENTS** when applying for a **VOTER REPLACEMENT CARD**?

Present any of the following Photo IDs:

- Fiji Passport; or
- FNPF Card; or
- Social Welfare ID; or
- T.I.N (Joint FIRCA / FNPF) Card; or
- Student ID from any Tertiary Institution registered with the Fiji Higher Education Commission.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You can only **REGISTER ONCE TO VOTE**. Double registration is unlawful.
- All registrations are to be done in person (You cannot register for someone else on their behalf).
- Provide accurate details on the application form e.g. Residential address.
- Update your voter identification card details when required.
- Keep your voter identification card safe and secure.
- Check for latest election information.
- Visit our FEO online Services Portal to verify your details by using the link: <http://services.feo.org.fj/PVL>. Simply enter your voter card number and date of birth to see your details.
- Reporting of Deceased voter. if you have family members who are registered voters and are deceased, you can notify the VSC of details of the deceased.
